| | Description | <p>- In East and West Africa, a number of studies have examined various aspects of the primary school leaver phenomenon: the aspirations of school leavers, the training and employment opportunities open to them, and their post-school histories.</p> <p>In Zambia, various Government ministries and commissions, some social service agencies, the University, city councils and the schools themselves have expressed concern over the emerging school leaver crisis. (In January, 1970, 50,000 primary school leavers will have no place in Zambian secondary schools.) No concerted attempt has yet been made however to analyse and to assess the proportion of the crisis.</p> <p>This project began with a survey of the literature on youth and primary school leavers throughout Africa. We have obtained materials with specific reference to Zambia, and have interviewed officials of the Zambian Government, social service organisations, educational institutions, business and industry, with regard to past and present conditions and future policy. This information is being used to assess the present situation with a view to making proposals for public policy.</p> <p>This initial survey of the entire school leaver problem will be followed by closer studies of several dimensions of the topic. For instance, a preliminary investigation has been made of the Zambia Youth Service as a case-study of an organisation created to meet the needs of school leavers, and we intend to pursue this inquiry in more detail. Studies of the post-school behaviour of adolescents in an urban area are also planned.</p> |
